Last week, the partners of the Horizon Europe project SITOLUB gathered in Berlin, Germany for their first in-person consortium meeting since the project's launch one year ago. Tekniker, project coordinator, guided the consortium to:

- Review progress: Discuss key achievements, address challenges, and refine project plans.
- Strengthen collaboration: Foster stronger relationships among partners and enhance communication channels.
- Disseminate results: Share preliminary findings and discuss potential avenues for knowledge dissemination and exploitation.

These models go beyond traditional assessments by considering safety, sustainability, and functional performance, including critical factors like viscosity, nano- and macro-scale properties, and socio-economic impacts.
